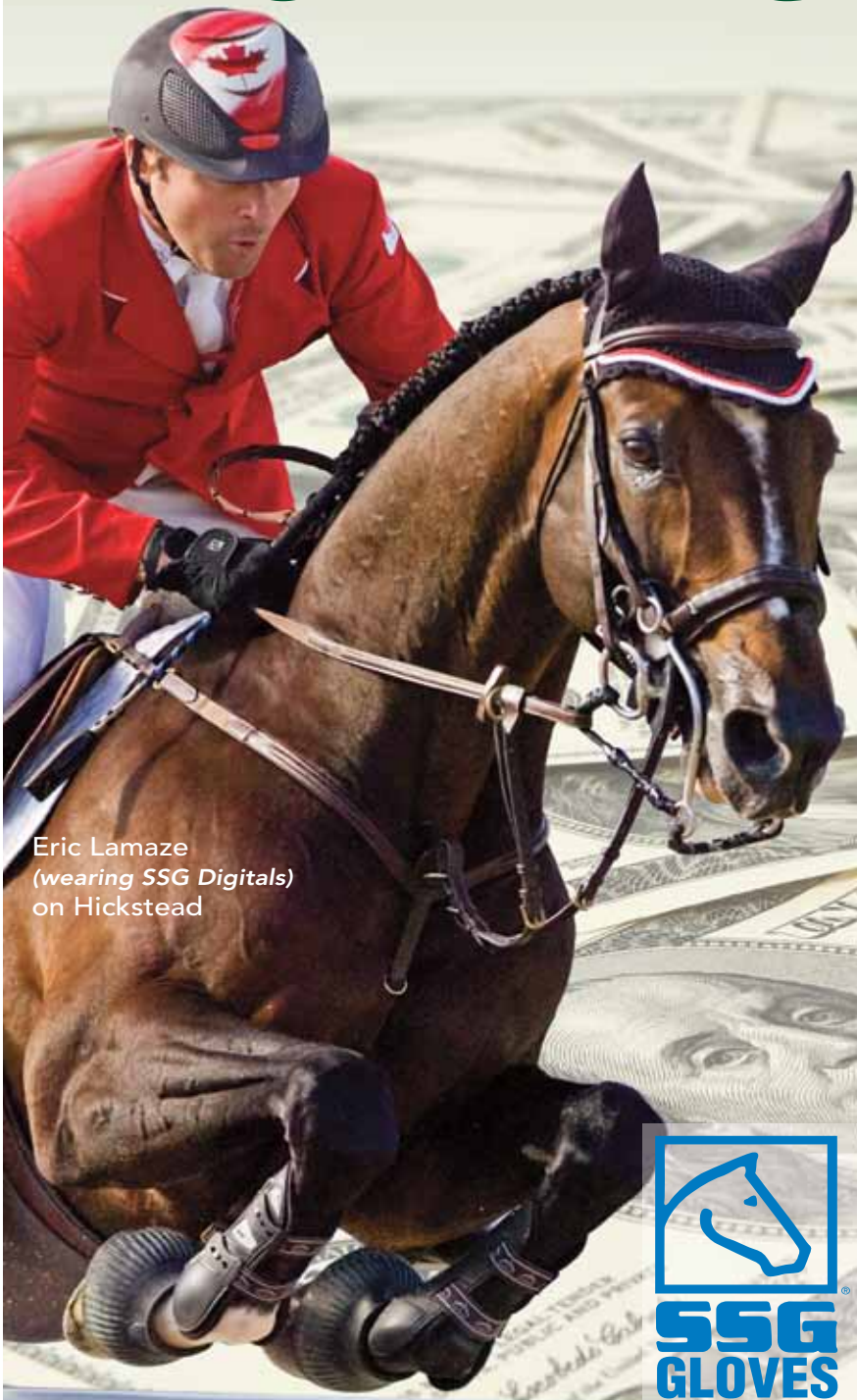

PONY HUNTERS SPECIFICATIONS

- Open to ponies ridden by junior riders subject to the following restrictions:
 - Junior "A" riders may ride large ponies only
 - Junior "B" and Junior "C" riders may ride ponies of all heights
 - Large ponies exceed 13.2 hands but do not exceed 14.2 hands
 - Medium ponies exceed 12.2 hands but do not exceed 13.2 hands
 - Small ponies do not exceed 12.2 hands
- Adults are permitted to show large ponies in miscellaneous non-point classes not restricted to juniors and adult amateurs may ride large ponies in adult amateur classes where fences do not exceed 3' (0.90 m). A pony shown by an adult may not be shown by a junior at the same competition.
- Juniors of any age may show any height of pony in miscellaneous non-point classes.
- See Article G302 for heights allowed in pony hunter classes.

Class #500 Pessoa USEF Hunter Seat Medal

Class Description: Open to junior active members of the USEF who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. To be shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles at 3'6" which must include one combination including an oxer and two changes of direction after first obstacle. A minimum of six to complete the class.

Class #501 ASPCA Maclay Medal

Class Description: Open to junior riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Rider and trainer must be current members of the ASPCA/NHSSA and must show their ASPCA numbers of the entry form. A minimum of six riders to fill class.

Class #502 Thunderbird Good Hands and Seat Medal 3'

Class description: Open to all junior and amateur riders. 3'0" Course will consist of 8 to 10 jumps with a minimum of 2 combinations, one will be a triple combination. A minimum of two changes of direction. Tack is not restricted and a triple or water jump may not be used. The top 15 scoring riders will be eligible to compete in the finals held at the Thunderbird Fort Langley Summer Festival. Finals class will call for a ride off.

Class #503 Thunderbird Good Hands and Seat Medal 3'6"

Class description: Open to all junior and amateur riders. 3'6" Course will consist of 8 to 10 jumps with a minimum of 2 combinations, one will be a triple combination. A minimum of two changes of direction. Tack is not restricted and a triple or water jump may not be used. The top 15 scoring riders will be eligible to compete in the finals held at the Thunderbird Fort Langley Summer Festival. Finals class will call for a ride off.

Class #504 CET Medal 3'6" to 3'9"

Class description: Open to all junior riders with gold members of Equine Canada and members of the Canadian Equestrian Team who have not reached their 21st birthday. Both Memberships must be in place to compete. Class is judged 60% over fences and 40% on the flat. The class will be run under jumper rules. The flat phase is to include lengthening of stride and counter canter. The over fences phase shall be over the type of course used in junior or preliminary jumper classes. There shall be at least ten fences 1.10 to 1.15m in height with spreads to 1.40m. A time allowed will be established based on 350 meters per minute. Change of tack is permitted between phases. No martingales in the flat phase and standing martingales are not permitted. Medal and ribbons to eighth place.

Class #505 CET Mini Medal Class 3'0" to 3'3"

Class Description: Open to Junior and Amateur riders who are members of Equine Canada. CET membership is not required. The be judged under the same rules and regulations as the CET Medal. No cross entry with the CET Medal at the same competition.

Class #506 BCHJA Adult Amateur Medal 3'0'

Class description: Open to amateur riders with current BCHJA membership.

Class #507 BCHJA Children's Medal 3'

Class description: Open to junior riders with current BCHJA membership.

Class #508 USEF Show Jumping Talent Search 3'6" - 3'9"

Class Description: Current membership required. Open to junior young riders who are members of the USEF and have not reached their 21st birthday. Competitors must use the same horse in both phases. A water jump, liverpool or a jump simulating water will be used in the jumper phase. The jumping phase of the class shall be over a course of at least ten fences 3'6" to 3'9" in height with spreads to 5'0". Each course must contain no fewer than three fences set at 3'9" in height. The course will include a double and a triple combination or three doubles. Twenty riders or 50% of entries (whichever is greater) will be called back for a second phase. Rider participation in the first phase whether it is Jumping or Flat phase, constitutes entry into the class as a whole regardless of whether the rider is called back for the second phase. Six riders must complete the course to fill.

Class #509, 510 and 511 WIHS Tad Coffin Performance Saddles Equitation Classic 3'6"

Class Description: Open to junior riders. To be shown in two rounds. One over a 3'6" hunter course and one over a 3'6" jumper course. There may be an optional work-off after the second round. Each phase will be pinned as a separate class. Scores from the first phase will determine the order of go in the second phase. The highest scores will return last. Riders may volunteer to move up in the order. The same horse must be used in all phases throughout the class. Points are awarded in the qualifying classes and the top 25 are eligible to go to the Washington International Horse Show to compete in the finals. Three riders must complete the course to fill.

Class # 512 THIS National Children's Medal

Class Description: Open to all junior members of the USEF and Equine Canada who have never competed in a Nation Equitation Final with fences at 3'6". The top four riders are required to perform a test of at least two individual tests from USEF test 1 through 19.

Class #513 Ariat National Adult Medal

Class Description: Open to all amateur members of the USEF and Equine Canada who are eligible to compete in the Adult Amateur Hunter Section of this show. The top four riders are required to perform a least two individual tests from USEF Tests 1-19.

Class #514 Jump Canada Hunter Seat Medal 3'6"

Class Description: Current EC Gold membership required. Judged 60% over fences and 40% flat. Mandatory ride off of top four. No change of tack between phases. Three must complete for class to qualify.

Exhibitors may not compete the same horse in the USHJA National Hunter Classic and the USHJA International Hunter Derby. USHJA National Hunter Classic is open to all riders. In order for National Hunter Classic points to be awarded, riders must complete a USHJA Exhibitor Declaration Form. Horses are not required to jog for soundness.

Course Requirements

Round One: Hunter Classic Course

- a. A minimum of ten obstacles must be offered in the Hunter Classic Round.
- b. Fence heights 3'0"
- c. There must be four option fences set at 3'5".
- d. At least one In and Out
- e. At least one Bending Line
- f. At least one line with an unrelated distance
- g. At least one long approach

Round Two: Handy Hunter Course

- a. A minimum of eight obstacles must be offered in the Handy Hunter Round.
- b. Fence height 3'0"
- c. There must be four option fences set at 3'5"
- d. The course should simulate riding over hunt country and must have a minimum of two handy options, such as: tight turns, different tracks, clever options for jump approaches, pen type obstacles, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle not to exceed 2'6" in height, halt and/or back. Gimmicky options are not appropriate.
- e. A minimum of twelve (12) entries, including horses tied for 12th place, must return for Round Two, if available. If more than 12 entries are to return for Round Two, it must be so stated in the Prize List. In that case, all horses tied for the last place designated to return will also be eligible to compete in Round Two.

2011 Jump Canada Young Horse Series

Jump Canada is pleased to support this multi province, multi event show jumping series for young jumpers in Canada, culminating with the Canadian Young Horse Championships. The purpose of this series is to encourage the development of young jumpers and give Canadian breeders some additional incentive to breed superior jumper prospects.

SPECIFICATIONS

All horses must be registered with the Young Horse Series through the Equine Canada office before they can accumulate any points at a competition. Points will not count unless all registration criteria have been received by Equine Canada. Points will start accruing from date of registration. Season entry fee per class per show: \$50.00 (no nomination fee) for 4, 5, 6 year old classes. 7/8 year old classes are at the discretion of show management (nomination fee may apply)

ELIGIBILITY

RIDERS

Open to all riders. Riders and Owners must be current Equine Canada Gold Sport License holders (or the equivalent) in good standing. Canadian Riders and owners must be members of their provincial hunter /jumper association.

HORSES

Open to four, five, six and seven/eight year old horses with recognized registration papers showing proof of age (the proof is the responsibility of the owner and the rider). Horses must have Equine Canada passports. Registration papers must be recognized by World Breeding Federation or the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation. The breeding of the horses must be shown on the entry form to be eligible for the Canadian breeder and other awards. Horses born after October 1 of the calendar year may compete in the age category of a horse that is born one year later.

AGE CATEGORY RULES AND HEIGHTS

4 Year Old - Jumps to be 1.0m to 1.10m. Time allowed at 300 meters per minute. Ribbons to sixth place. Table A, no jump off. Faults will be converted to points for 50% of the score (performance), and 50% of the score will be based on style. Knockdown or first refusal: -5 points off performance score. Time Faults: 1 T.F. = -1 off performance score.

5 Year old - Jumps to be 1.10m to 1.20m. Time allowed at 325 meters per minute. Ribbons and Prize money to sixth place. Scoring: FEI Article 238.2.2.

6 Year Old - Jumps to be 1.20 m to 1.30 m. Ribbons and Prize money to sixth place. Scoring: FEI Article 238.2.2.

7/8 Year Old - Jumps to be 1.30 m to 1.40 m. Class may be run combined with 1.35m Jumper class. Entry fee and prize money for the class is at the discretion of the show management. Scoring: FEI Article 238.2.2. When combined in a 1.35m or 1.40m Jumper class, points will be calculated based on the number of Seven Year Olds/ Eight Year Olds that are registered with this series competing in the class, not the total number of horses competing.

Round 1 will be a regular classic course with up to 10 fences a maximum of 3' in height. A maximum of 10 bonus points may be awarded by each judge to each horse/rider combination for jumping style, quality and movement. The top 12 horses will return for round 2.

ROUND 2

Round 2 will be a Handy Hunter course, with up to 8 fences with handy options and may include trot jumps, open gate while mounted, roll back and option jumps. An additional 10 bonus points may be awarded by each judge to each horse/rider combination for handiness of round and brilliance of pace.

- b. Fence height 3'6" to 4'0", with a maximum of 50% of the jumps set at 3'6"
- c. There must be four 4'0" to 4'3" fences in the course, set as option jumps
- d. At least one In and out
- e. At least one Bending Line
- f. At least one line with an unrelated distance
- g. One long approach
- h. Jumps:
 - Obstacles must simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and course must offer a variety of Derby jumps with different appearances such as: natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence or gate, coop, aiken, hedge, oxer, brush, logs, natural foliage.

One USEF "R" judge who will be officiating for the class and a veterinarian must be present. All horses entered in the class must jog for soundness in order to be eligible to compete. Unsoundness during the competition will be reflected in the scores from the judges (GR 1031.7). Following consultation with the veterinarian, the decision of the judge is final.

FEI Childrens International Jumping Competition

The FEI Children's International Jumping qualifier classes should provide a learning experience for the contestants. These classes are a starting point for the riders to learn about FEI standards, a stepping stone to Young Riders, and an introduction to international competition.

SPECIFICATIONS

This competition consists of two phases, each phase has two rounds run under Table A.

RIDER

Open to riders between the ages of 12-14. Riders must be registered with the FEI in the current year (this is free of charge for athletes under the age of 18) and horses must be entered in the FEI database in order to have an FEI ID; however yearly registration of the horses is not compulsory. If the rider is eliminated in the first phase they are still eligible to compete in the second phase.

HORSE

Riders are not limited to the number of horses that they may ride in this event but the score of only one horse may count for points. The horse that will be collecting points must be declared in writing to the FEI prior to the start of the competition. This horse must be ridden first and the score of the second horse will not count towards world wide standings. The horse must be at least 6 years of age.

COURSE

1. The course of the first round of each competition will consist of between ten and twelve obstacles including two doubles or one double and one treble. There will be no water jump but obstacles that include a water ditch may be used.
2. The course of the second round of each competition will consist of between eight and ten obstacles including one double or one treble.
3. The courses will be designed by experienced FEI Course Designers, designated by the FEI Jumping Committee. The courses for the Gold and Silver Tours will be identical;
